NAVTTC together with TVET Sector Support Programme (SSP) is planning to establish a pool of nationally certified competency Assessors to conduct the assessment of trainees under different vocational courses. The TVET Sector Support Programme is mainly funded by the European Union and the Federal Republic of Germany. The TVET SSP is implemented by the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH in close collaboration with the National Vocational and Technical Training Commission (NAVTTC) as well as provincial Technical Education and Vocational Training Authorities (TEVTAs) and private sector organizations.

What is meant of Competency Assessors?

The role of the competency assessor is to assess skills, knowledge and attitude to ensure that the competence and/or knowledge demonstrated meets the requirements of National Competence Standards. He/she therefore need to have occupational expertise in the areas to be assessed. They will be required to update their expertise by being involved in continuous professional development activities.

Training and Assessment Program

Step 1: Submission of application.

Step 2: Training schedule notification.

Step 3: Attending 05-day training.

Step 4: Portfolio completion (home assignment).

Step 5: One-day final assessment for certification.

- 5 years industry and, or academic experience (current) within the assessment field of occupation
- TVET qualification (at least six months certificate/ diploma), DAE, B.Tech, B.Tech (Hons), BSc or BS Engineering or equivalent.
- Preference will be given to those having IT and reporting skills
